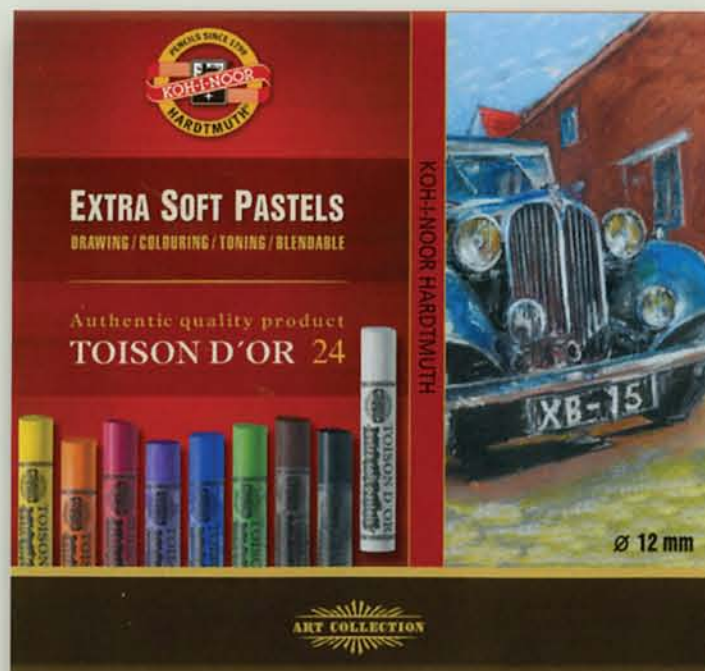

The history and use of TOISON D'OR Soft Pastels



The use of soft pastels can be dated back to the 15th century. Old masters such as daVinci, Raphael and Michelangelo began using soft pastels in preliminary drawings and sketches. The Italian painters of the Cinquecento are often considered the pioneers of this delicate media. Drawing was a vital part of the artistic process, and was essential in creating major works of art. The soft and airy qualities of pastel made it a favorite medium for portrait artists of the Baroque era. Its popularity continued well into the 19th century and was an ideal for drawing and painting the elusive characteristics of light that Impressionists admired.

Today, soft pastels are still a favored medium among artists. Used alone, they can create tightly composed works that resemble photography, or soft and abstract pieces. When used with other media, such as paint or graphite, the results are often stunning and unexpected.

Key components of this remarkable pastel are very pure, micro-pulverized natural pigments on a calcium carbonate base. Mixed with other additives and binders, the resulting product offers quality and light permanency, ensuring artists that the pieces they create will not only be vibrant, but durable as well.

The Toison D'or extra soft pastel is a time-honored product of the Koh-I-Noor brand. With a wide color range and minimum binding elements, this pastel offers a silky stroke and low adhesion to paper and other substrates. No components in these pastels contain toxic or otherwise harmful substances, making them suitable for most artists.

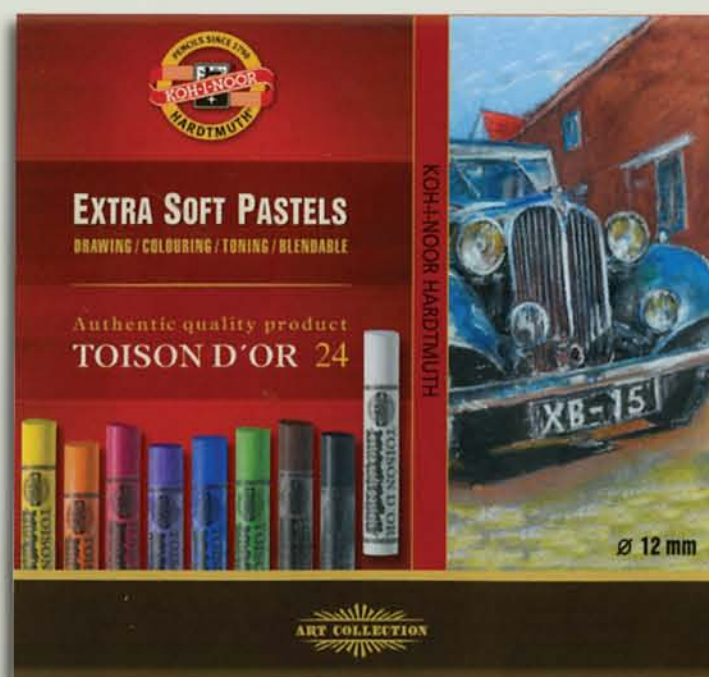
